DUAL TEAM YOUTH WRESTLING TOURNAMENT

Goal: To develop a team youth wrestling tournament that will create excitement, comradery and competition for youth wrestling communities in Wisconsin

Date: Sunday, January 17, 2016

Times: Weigh-In/Skin Check 7:30-8:00AM

Team Pictures/Coach's Meeting to follow

Time schedule will be released after all the teams are confirmed for the tournament.

****NOTE**** Each round will start as soon as all duals from the previous round are completed, except a brief break to reset brackets after round 2.

Tournament Info:

- **ALL OF YOUR TEAM MEMBERS MUST EITHER LIVE IN YOUR SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BE CURRENTLY GOING TO A SCHOOL IN YOUR DISTRICT THAT FUNNELS TO YOUR HIGH SCHOOL.**
- Each team must supply 1 table worker per round (They will be assigned to score or time the dual)
- Anyone in 8th grade or younger is allowed to compete—no minimum age limit
- You may weigh in as many wrestlers as you wish at each weight and as many total wrestlers as you wish
- You may only move a wrestler up one weight class from the weight they weigh in at—ex. 107.6 is eligible for 108 and 114

General Info:

- A goal is to have 5 rounds for all teams
- Full-sized mats
- WIAA officials will be used
- EMT/Trainer will be on site
- Full concessions available
- Hospitality room (for officials and 3 coaches per team)
- Exhibition matches available
- Programs available
- All WIAA High School rules will prevail.

- Team entry: \$200 per team (entry fee needed by October 31 to secure spot)
- Admission: \$5 per person (under 6 free)—competing athletes and 3 listed coaches free

Weigh-Ins:

- Weights: 68, 75, 82, 87, 92, 97, 102, 108, 114, 120, 127, 134, 142, 155, HWT (max 220)
- Starting weight will be drawn at the coaches meeting—each round will start one weight higher than the previous round
- Check scale available
- Tenths will be covered (ex. 92.9 is 92lbs)
- Schools will weigh-in as a team and be pictured directly following weigh-ins
- Weights at time of your teams weigh-in will be final

Awards:

- Team trophies for 1st, 2nd in gold division and 1st in silver division when applicable
- T-shirts and medals for team champions (gold division), medals for runner-up (gold division)—25 per team
